

## Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

NeuLion, Inc. is making this slavery and human trafficking statement on behalf of itself and its subsidiaries (collectively, "NeuLion," "we" or "our"), in relation to the fiscal year ended December 31, 2016, pursuant to Section 54 of the United Kingdom's Modern Slavery Act 2015.

### *Our Business and Supply Chain*

NeuLion is a leading provider of enterprise digital video solutions, with the mission to deliver and enable the highest quality live and on-demand digital video content experiences anywhere and on any device. We have subsidiaries around the globe, including in the United Kingdom. Through a subsidiary in China, we purchase set-top boxes from a supplier in China.

### *Our Policies on Slavery and Human Trafficking*

We neither support nor tolerate slavery or human trafficking. We are dedicated to honest and open communication with our employees and suppliers, as well as to fairness through adherence to all applicable laws, regulations and policies. In addition, NeuLion is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy work environment, promoting a workplace that is free from discrimination or harassment based on race, color, religion, sex or other grounds prohibited by applicable law, and supporting fair competition.

### *Our Assessment*

Given these commitments, the nature of our business, and that we sell only a limited number of set-top boxes, we believe that there is inherently a limited risk of slavery and human trafficking taking place in our business and supply chain. We addressed the issue to our supplier in China. Based on the results of that query and our own employment practices, we have no reason to believe that slavery or human trafficking took place in our business or supply chain during the reporting period.

### *Our Initiatives*

We are committed to ensuring that this remains the case, and to developing and implementing an appropriate program to make our employees and suppliers aware of our policy regarding modern slavery and human trafficking, and are considering several initiatives to further these goals.
